

# CAMP PACKING CHECKLIST



For a fun and stress-free camp experience, we recommend that your child helps to pack their own belongings, so that they are familiar with where everything is. Below is a handy checklist to use at home and at Woodhouse to ensure nothing is missed on either side. Please ensure that all items are named.

### In a Backpack:

	Food / Drink	Packed morning tea and lunch for day 1
	Food/ Drink	Drink bottle (at least 1L capacity)
	Personal	Sunscreen (cream or roll on, no spray)
	Clothing	Wide-brimmed hat x 1
	Clothing	Waterproof rain coat OR rain poncho x 1
	Clothing	Warm jacket OR Jumper x 1

### In an Overnight Bag:

	Clothing	Enclosed shoes x 2
	Clothing	Pants x # of days + 1 spare (long pants recommended)
	Clothing	Shirt / t-shirt x # of days + 1 spare
	Clothing	Jumper x 2
	Clothing	Underwear x # of days + 1 spare
	Clothing	Pairs of socks x # of days + 1 spare
	Clothing	Beanie / gloves x 1
	Miscellaneous	Plastic Bags x 2 (for dirty clothes)
	Miscellaneous	Named Torch (and spare batteries)
	Miscellaneous	Tea towel <b>OR if tent camping</b> named plate, bowl, cup, spoon, knife, fork and 2 x tea towels (in a bag)
	Toiletries	Thongs / sandals (for the shower only)
	Toiletries	Bath Towel x 2
	Toiletries	Face towel
	Toiletries	Soap / shampoo / conditioner
	Toiletries	toothbrush & toothpaste
	Toiletries	Brush / comb / hairties
	Toiletries	Deodorant ( <b>*NO AEROSOLS</b> )
	Sleeping	Sleeping bag or quilt
	Sleeping	Fitted sheet <b>OR if tent camping</b> extra blanket
	Sleeping	Pillow
	Sleeping	Pyjamas
	Sleeping	Teddy or stuffed toy (optional)

### DO NOT BRING:

Aerosols - hairspray, deodrant, spray on sunscreen, etc
